Did You Know that Wild Interiors® Succulents...

Prefer bright, indirect sunlight and temperatures between 65°F and 85°F

Can move to areas of more or less light, but they need to do it gradually

Can get sunburn. Brown or black spots on the leaves means a succulent is getting too much sun. Move it to a different spot.

Can stretch to find light. Spaced out leaves on a succulent's stem means it's time to move it to a sunnier location.

Require very little water to thrive. All Wild Interiors® succulents come in a plastic grower pot that sits inside a clay pot. To water, pour in about 1" of water into the outer pot and place the grower pot inside. The plant will soak up the water from bottom. This helps you avoid overwatering.

Need to dry out completely between waterings. Succulents are susceptible to root rot, so good drainage is a must.

Require occasional grooming. Remove dead leaves to promote full, uniform growth.

Are easily propagated. Remove leaves and plant them in soil, following usual succulent care instructions.
